INTERNATIONAL FACULTY

D. NAGESHWAR REDDY (INDIA)

Prof Reddy is the Chairman & Chief of Gastroenterology & Therapeutic Endoscopy, Asian Institute of Gastroenterology, Hyderabad, India. In 2004, He was elected as Honorary Life Member American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy for lifetime achievement in Gastrointestinal Endoscopy. Only 10 Gastroenterologists in the world have been given this honor over the last 50 Years up to 2004.

G. V. RAO (INDIA)

Prof Rao is the Director & Chief of Gastrointestinal & Minimally Invasive Surgery, Asian Institute of Gastroenterology Hyderabad, India. His areas of interest are Hepato Pancreato Biliary Surgery, Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery, Esophageal Surgery, Endoscopic Surgery, and Per Oral Trans Gastric Endoscopic Surgery.

SHIV K. SARIN (INDIA)

Prof Sarin is the Director of Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences (ILBS), the first dedicated institution for advanced research on liver diseases. His researches have helped describe two major liver diseases: Portal Biliopathy and Acute-on-Chronic Liver Failure (ACLF). He has developed or significantly contributed to the development of several treatment protocols for liver diseases such as the band ligation to prevent variceal hemorrhage which has since become a standard procedure practiced worldwide. He has done known work on Gastric varices and their classification bears his name as Sarin's Classification of Gastric Varices. Seventeen major treatment protocols have been credited to him including five major Asian Pacific Treatment Guidelines in Liver disease and the model he proposed on endotoxemia induced portal hypertension and liver disease is reported to have been universally accepted.

LAURENT CASTERA (FRANCE)

Dr. Castera is currently as EASL Secretary General. He completed his training in Hepatology as Assistant Professor in the department of Hepatology and Gastroenterology at the University of Paris-XI (Hôpital Bicêtre) until 1997. Then he spent three years as a research fellow at the INSERM Unit 99 in the laboratory of Prof. Jean-Michel Pawlotsky (Hôpital Henri Mondor, Créteil) where he worked on different aspects of hepatitis viruses resistance to antiviral therapy, using a quasispecies approach. He earned his Doctoral degree in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology from the University of Paris-XII in 2007. Meanwhile, he was appointed Médecin des Hôpitaux in 2001 and moved to the department of Hepatology and Gastroenterology of the University Hospital of Bordeaux where he started to develop clinical research on novel approaches for the non-invasive evaluation of liver fibrosis, based on the measurement of liver stiffness using transient elastography.

LAWRENCE HO KHEK YU (SINGAPORE)

Prof Ho is Senior Consultant, Division of Gastroenterology & Hepatology, National University Hospital, Singapore. He is an accomplished endoscopist who has been invited to perform live case demonstrations in numerous international endoscopy workshops. He chairs the Asian Endoscopic Ultrasonography Group, which is a platform for leading EUS experts to promote endoscopic ultrasonography training and professional development of endosonographers in the Asian region. As co-inventor for the ground-breaking technology of the Master and Slave Transluminal Endoscopic Robot (MASTER), he was part of the team who developed the world's first flexible robotic endoscopy system, which was successfully used to perform endoscopic submucosal dissection in human patients.

HIROYUKI ISAYAMA (JAPAN)

He is Associate Professor of Department of Gastroenterology, Graduate School of Medicine, The University of Tokyo, Japan. He is President of International workshop, T-CAP (Tokyo Conference of Asian Pancreato-biliary Interventional Endoscopy). Achievements include research in biliary stenting; research in pancreato-biliary intervention and endoscopy.

HITOSHI MARUYAMA (JAPAN)

He is Associate Professors of Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Chiba University Hospital, Japan. His areas of expertise are Liver and Gastrointestinal Diseases. His researches were published on international journals. He also published several books about liver and gastrointestinal diseases.

EVELIEN DEKKER (THE NETHERLANDS)

Prof Evelien Dekker is a Professor of Gastrointestinal Oncology, specializing in screening and diagnosing colorectal carcinoma, at the Amsterdam Medical Center (AMC). She is a member of the board of Procolo, an innovative center of expertise for colonoscopy. Colon cancer is a key focus of Dekker's research, and her research group studies the screening methods for intestinal cancer, the quality and advanced technical developments within colonoscopy, the treatment of intestinal polyps and the early stages of intestinal cancer, and hereditary intestinal cancer and polyposis syndromes.

KL. GOH (MALAYSIA)

Professor Goh Khean Lee or better known as Prof KL Goh is a knowledgeable and highly experienced gastroenterologist who has helped established gastroenterology (which includes gastrointestinal endoscopy and hepatology) as a specialty in the country. He has spent more than 30 years as a specialist in the field and is senior consultant at the University of Malaya Specialist Centre and the University of Malaya Medical Centre. At the latter, he is Head of Gastroenterology and Hepatology as well as Chief of the Combined Endoscopy unit. The endoscopy unit at the University of Malaya Medical Centre has been recognized as a "Centre of Excellence" by the World Digestive Endoscopy Organization from 2008. A leading academician in the country, he was awarded the highly prestigious "Merdeka award" for outstanding scholastic achievement in 2011. A personable doctor and an expert in gastrointestinal and liver diseases, Professor Goh has been practicing at the University of Malaya Specialist Centre since 2000.

JIN- LIN HOU (CHINA)

Professor Jin-Lin Hou is the Director and Professor of the Hepatology Unit and Department of Infectious Diseases, Nanfang Hospital, Southern Medical University. His current research interests include the clinical management of viral hepatitis and the molecular virology and immunology of hepatitis B virus (HBV) and severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS) infection.

KIERON LIM BOON LENG (SINGAPORE)

Prof Lim is currently Head of the Division of Gastroenterology & Hepatology, National University Hospital, and Assistant Professor at Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore. He is the clinical lead in Transplant Hepatology at the National University Centre for Organ Transplantation (NUCOT). He also holds an adjunct appointment as Assistant Professor and faculty at the Division of Liver Diseases, Ichan School of Medicine at Mount Sinai New York, USA. His special interests include liver transplantation, hepatocellular carcinoma and viral hepatitis.

KRISHNAKUMAR MADHAVAN [SINGAPORE]

Prof Madhavan is Senior Consultant and the concurrent Head of Surgery as well as the Division of Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery. He is also Director of the Liver Transplantation Programme and the Co-Director of the National University Centre for Organ Transplantation (NUCOT). He also played a vital role in setting up the NUH Pancreas Transplantation Programme in Singapore. He led the NUH surgical team to perform Singapore's first two simultaneous pancreas-kidney transplantations at the NUH successfully.

STEPHEN CHANG [SINGAPORE]

Prof Chang is the founding President of the Hepatopancreatobiliary Association of Singapore. He is a key developer of the laparoscopic approach to Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery in this region and is also active in developing the Living Donor Liver Transplant Program in Singapore. He is the pioneer of the Single Incision Laparoscopic Surgery and was the first among the first in the world to publish his experience in single incision laparoscopic gall bladder surgery, liver resection and pancreas resection.

SWAN N THUNG [USA]

Prof Swan Thung is Anatomic and Clinical Pathologist at Mount Sinai Hospital, USA. Her research interest has been in liver disease and liver pathology, which spans from acute processes to chronic liver diseases with or without fibrosis, cirrhosis and liver tumors. She was the Director of Morphology Assessment Core Laboratory of the Department of Gene and Cell Medicine.

VINAY DHIR [INDIA]

Dr. Dhir is the Director and Chief of endoscopy of Baldota Institute of Digestive Sciences, Mumbai, India. His principle interests are Interventional hepatobiliary endoscopy including interventional EUS. He is the Secretary of Association of Interventional GI Endoscopy of India (AIGE). Recently he has created a 3D printing model for hands on training in EUS-guided biliary drainage.

REUBEN WONG KONG MIN [SINGAPORE]

Dr. Wong is Gastrointestinal specialist currently practicing at Singapore. He introduced the use of High Resolution Manometry in Singapore to measure pressures in the gastrointestinal tract, enabling new clinical insight into the diagnosis and management of esophageal disorders. He also established the Gastroenterology-Psychology multi-disciplinary service, which has provided an alternative treatment approach to IBS. He was also part of the team that introduced Fecal Microbiota Transplantation locally.

CHENG JUN [SINGAPORE]

Dr. Cheng Jun is a Consultant Internist & Gastroenterologist at the Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre. He is a Master Endoscopist, specializing in ERCP and therapeutic gastroscopy and colonoscopy. He was previously the Past President of the Gastroenterological Society of Singapore, Past Vice-President of the World Organization of Gastroenterology, Board Member of the National Foundation of Digestive Diseases and past Chairman of the Chapter of Physicians, Academy of Medicine, Singapore.
